

## TEQIP-II Review meeting

TEQIP-II review meeting was organised by SPFU Mumbai on 20.05.2014 at SPFU office, Mumbai for TEQIP-II funded Institutions. Total 07 Institutions from Maharashtra had presented their progress and measures taken to achieve 10 KPI's. Prof. J.B. Dr. Abhay Wagh had raised following points to the notice to the TEQIP-II Institutes for implementation.

1. Procurement before December 2014
2. Finishing School:- Identify academically weak students, Activities for weak student.
3. Curriculum development cell (outcome base syllabus design).
4. Counselling to all students regarding TEQIP program. Communicate all activities under TEQIP program to all student's as well as teaching and non-teaching staff.
5. Beautification of campus / Environmental framework management of Institute related 18 point check list to be check/ review every month.
6. CSR
7. Maintain register for users of equipment's purchased under TEQIP
8. Performance and data audit for the year 2013-14 on or before October 2014
9. Statutory audit for the year 2013-14 on or before October 2014.
10. Data Entry: 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14, before 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014
11. MIS entry for the year 2013-14 before 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014.
12. Mandatory participation of all Institutes in CII -AICTE
18. Participation of faculty, staff and students in TEQIP.
