# Points listed are not in the order of discussion but capture the essence of the meeting

- 1. The meeting started with Dr. Preeti Agarwal , the organizing secretary of the event welcoming all the dignitaries present for the meeting
- 2. Prof. Agarwal opened the discussion asking the President of CMIA to suggest names for, the panelists for discussion. She also suggested that they should be from stratified areas so that all the topics should be covered.
- 3. During the discussion the CMIA President, Mr. Sunil Raithatta, made a valuable suggestion, that the presentations of the students should not be limited to the participants from Avishkar '12, but the universities participating in the summit can also promote their research scholars, so that the Industry experts who will also be a part of the summit could evaluate them as well as utilize them in practical.
- 4. Also it was unanimously decided that the No. of Presentations would be limited to a maximum of 30 students, and the list would be freezed by 10<sup>th</sup> of Feb.
- 5. It was also decided that the Inaugural ceremony would be made short so that maximum time can be utilized in the discussion which is the main motive of the summit. The Preface and Objective of the program will be given by Dr. Sudhir Meshram and Dr. Pandhripande and also that the inaugural address will be given by CMIA President, followed by Shri Sunil Bagul (President Rotary). 7.	It was also decided that invitation letters for the Summit would be sent to the above dignitaries and other members of CMIA and Rotary. The Final list of the Panelists would be mailed to the VC office by $12^{\rm th}$ of Feb.
8.	The structure of the Panel was decided to be 5 members from the Industry and 3 members from Academics.
9.	It was also decided that from the above lists experts would also be selected to judge the presentation of the students.
10.	From among the 30 students the top 3 presentations will be awarded with a cash prize of Rs 10000.
11.	During the discussion, it was concluded that Rotary would take the responsibility of sponsoring the kits and also that the local hospitability, Banners and Hall arrangements ,at Rama International would be taken care by them.
12.	Dr. Pandhripande, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, BAMU, volunteered that he would arrange to send 10 Management students to co-ordinate the event. Also he willingly accepted to arrange for pick and drop of any Vice Chancellors' or other important university authorities participating in the summit. Prof. Shirsat would co-ordinate the same, on behalf of BAMU.
13.	It was also decided that in the Valedictory session guests to share the dais could be taken from the panelists being present.
