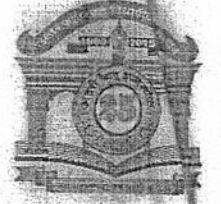


Copies of the above Resolution and Revised draft of Ordinance passed by the Management Council are submitted herewith.

Semi Government and Charitable blood bank. Hence this ordinance is being amended.

ORDINANCE FOR GRANT OF ADDITIONAL MARKS FOR BLOOD DONATION

This Ordinance shall have immediate effect.

1. Notwithstanding, anything contained in any other Ordinance, 2 additional marks be granted to candidate appearing for University examinations of any degree, diploma or certificate, as an incentive, for blood donation by him / her.
2. Two (2) additional marks
  - a) shall be added - to any head/s of passing or to any subject/s, as the case may be, in the examination, if the student is failing in such head/s of passing / subject/s and if such additional marks enable the student to get necessary passing marks or:
  - b) shall be added to any subject if such additional marks enable the student to get benefits of exemption, such additional marks only as are required for examination shall be given for passing, exemption, ATKT.
  - c) If additional marks are not given under clause (a) and/or (b) then eligible additional marks shall be added to the total marks secured by candidate in the examination.
  - d) The benefit of 2 marks can be availed only once the entire duration of degree / diploma to which he / she is enrolled.
  - e) The additional marks under this ordinance shall be taken into consideration for the purpose of award of any prize, scholarship, merit list or for such other similar purposes.
3. The additional marks shall be granted to the student subject to the conditions mentioned hereunder :
  - i) Blood should have been donated in any of the Government recognized blood bank (Government, Semi Government or Charitable). Whether the blood bank is recognized by the Government as above or else shall be verified by the Principal of college / Head of the Recognised Institution and DSW
  - ii) The candidate, seeking benefit under this ordinance, shall have to submit attested photocopy of certificated of blood donation and attested photocopy of blood donation card alongwith a University prescribed form to the Principal of the concerned college.
  - iii) The applications received will be verified and forwarded by the Principal to the Director, Student Welfare of the University on or before 31<sup>st</sup> January of the academic year.
  - iv) These additional marks will be added in the ensuing examinations of the same academic year.
4. A student shall submit an application before the date of commencement of his examination for the grant of additional marks alongwith necessary original certificate or copies thereof countersigned by the Principal of the College / Head of the Recognised Institution. No application received after commencement of examination shall be entertained by the University.
5. If any difficulty arises in giving effect to provisions of this Ordinance, the Vice-Chancellor may, in consultation with the Dean of the faculty concerned, give his decision shall be final and binding in such matters.
6. The benefit made available under this ordinance is not a matter of right of the student, but it is an incentive only.
